- What are at least TWO reasons why the “rebirth” of classic Greek and Roman styles happen here instead of other Italian city-states?



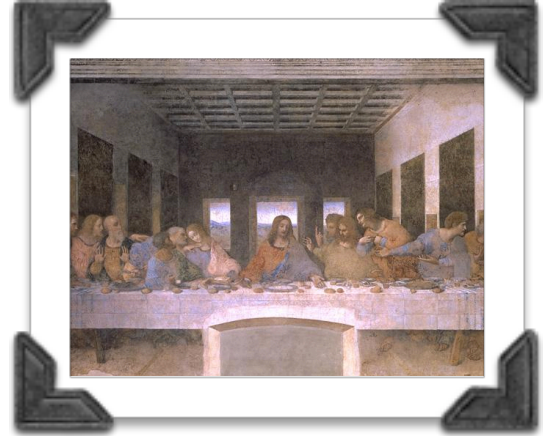
